NAD aspires to make the vision of Digital Academic Certificates for every Indian Student a reality and promises to do away with difficulties/inefficiencies of collecting, maintaining, and presenting physical academic certificates. A direct integration with Boards, Universities, and Academic Institutions ensures **authenticity of every certificate record** that is uploaded on the NAD system. More than 350 Academic Institutions across India have enrolled themselves with NDML for NAD services till now.

The Panjab University has already signed the SLA with NDML. The process of data upload on NAD has already started. In order to benefit from this initiative, it is important that all the students of your college/Dept must know about and register on the NAD system. Registered students are able to view their academic certificates. All the students can create their own account on NAD portal. Therefore, to facilitate your students to understand and join NAD, you can follow below mentioned activities.

- 2. Click on Join now.

- 4. Enter your Contact details.
- 5. Upload your recent photographs and signature.
- 6. Enter your current recent past Academic details. Enter the type& State of the university currently and select your university from the list of university given.
- 7. Create a User ID & Password for yourself with given specifications and click submit.
- 8. Enter the OTP receive on your phone and click verify to complete the registration without Aadhaar for NAD ID. Acknowledgement printout to your college/university for activation of your account.
 - 9. Click on login to access your NAD Account.
- 10. Click on My account tab and then view Account details to know your NAD ID.
