**INSTRUCTION FOR ADMISSION TO VARIOUS COURSES  
FOR THE SESSION 2022-2023**

Respected Sir/Madam,

In continuation to this office e-mail no.5000/R&S dated 04/07/2022, it is informed that the following amendments has been made in Admission Guidelines for the Session 2022-23, may be read as under:-

**General Information (v) at page no. 1.**

When an admission notice is given in the Newspapers/Website by the respective College, it should be clearly mentioned therein that the candidates coming from other Universities/Boards/Councils/Bodies must submit their qualifying examination Certificates, in original, at the time of admission. Lower pass examination certificate, Migration Certificate etc. be submitted latest by **20th October 2022** in the University Office. If Result Gazette/original documents are not available, then student should submit an affidavit to the effect that if the documents are not found correct, his/her admission to the course will liable to be cancelled.

**17. (v) Submission of Registration Return at page no. 18.**

- (i) The last date for receipt of Registration Return and data entered through Web application software with regard to Registration/Continuation Returns of various courses along with complete documents from the Principals/Chairpersons/Directors of the affiliated & constituent Colleges/Teaching Departments/Regional Centres of the University is **20th October** of the year of admission.
- (ii) Thereafter the requisite documents, in original, shall be accepted with Penalty, per student as under:-

21st October to 31st October	:	Rs.1,000/-
1st November to 15 <sup>th</sup> November	:	Rs.2,000/-
16th November to 30th November (of the year following the admission)	:	Rs.5,000/-

The Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor shall have the authority to accept the documents in the case of hardship, beyond 30<sup>th</sup> November up to 7 working days before the commencement of semester examination
